General Comments					
This site visit was a routine inspection. The farm consists of 1 barn. The permit allows for 5,000 finishers and 1,000 nursery pigs. There were 1,500 finishers onsite. The permit expires on 5-10-21.  A review of the operating record requirements was completed. All operating record requirements were present and up-to-date. Marketing and distribution records were reviewed.  Manure has been given to local farmers. Kopkey was hired to apply the manure. The last manure sample was received on 4-16-18. Shane's consultant, Kristin Whittington, has a fertilizer distributor license from the State Chemist. She claims that she supervises marketing and distribution of manure from this farm. None of the operators of the farm have the license.  A visual inspection of the farm revealed that all permitted structures were in good condition. The ground had been graded and seeded with visible vegetation started. The perimeter tile sump pit was sampled for ammonia nitrogen. Ammonia nitrogen was detected at 1ppm. Ms. Whittington indicated that she would provide an ammonia nitrogen sample kit to the operators so that they can sample the ground water in the future. The sump pit riser had a cover.  Dead animals are composted. CFO# 6894 was inspected immediately prior to this inspection.  Description of Violations and Further Actions  The findings noted in this report do not include a compliance evaluation for the submittal of required construction notifications, construction affidavits, facility change notifications, as-built plans, waste storage structure closures, and special compliance monitoring reports or data.
